

Historical Research Collections- Searching by Location:

- Alphabetically by Collection
- Size of Collection
- · Last Updated


Searching by Location provides a comprehensive list of collections both indexed and browsable only.

When searching any collection be sure to click on the "learn more" link to find out the size, scope and range of the collection.

Browsing the collection allows you to view the records in context and find connections that every-name searching might miss.



#### Historical Research Collections- Searching by Collection:



- Sorted alphabetically by Collection
- Size of collection
- Last updated
- Searchable by keyword

If you search by size of the collection, the bottom of the list will be unpaginated collections that are browsable only.

#### Historical Research Collections- Search Filters:

- Using search filters can help you zero in on probable ancestors
- You can narrow your search by date, location, record type and sex
- You can layer your filters to narrow your results

#### Use FamilySearch in tandem with other online collections:

Scotland's People allows you to search their indexes for free, but charges for copies of the records. You can use that information to find additional information about your ancestors in Familysearch.

Additional examples include Find-A-Grave and the Cook County Genealogy website from the Cook County Clerk's Office.

#### FamilySearch Images:

- Images searchable by location & topic
- Image collections are discoverable in the catalog with the DGS number provided


#### FamilySearch Family Trees:

- Family Trees are 100% collaborative
- Anyone can add or delete information
- Changes are tracked

- Personal images & files can be attached
- Watch lists can be created to alert you when an ancestor has been updated

- IGI: International Genealogical Index
- Pedigree Resource File
- Guild of One-Name Studies
- Ancestral File
- Partner and Community Trees



FamilySearch Genealogies utilize numerous collections, some of these collections like the IGI are no longer updated. Take the information with a grain of salt.

### FamilySearch Books:

- Hundreds of thousands of books from major genealogical research centers like BYU Family History Library, Allen County Public Library, Mid-Continent Public Library and many more
- Many books, company journals and family newsletters are available published after 1924
- Many items are available to download as a PDF
- Some items are restricted to Family History Centers only
- Text searchable- You can search by name, company, religious organization, cemetery and so much more!
