This database is available as a private subscription with discounts through Ancestry.com or can be accessed through some public and university libraries


Browsing the Collection

Try browsing the Fold3 collection first to become accustomed to the way the site is organized

- 1. View the full Title List at the upper right side of the screen
- 2. Searching inside each collection or record set is available any time
- 3. Modify or narrow search within the search results
- 4. Download the files you want to keep or save them to your Ancestry.com account

Searching the Collection

To maximize search results, do not begin your search on the main page. This will search the entire site, and can be very frustrating if you are not an experienced user. Instead, try selecting a specific collection, and using the grey search box at the top of the page to narrow your results. You can always fine tune your results after your initial search.
