Attendance Days

Enrollment Policy

First Friends Christian Preschool admits students of any color ethnic origin or nationality.

Members of Friendship Church receive first preference for placement. Children must be the appropriate age by September 1st and be toilet trained.

Health and Safety Requirements

Before admittance into the preschool, all children must have on file a health examination form completed by their doctor. that includes proof of chickenpox immunity or vaccination, lead and TB tests (or waivers), and be dated within six months prior to enrollment. A certified copy of the student's birth certificate must be presented for photocopying prior to admittance.

When are fees due?
