

GREAT READING RACE: REGISTRATION

STEP ONE: Visit fountaindale.org/grr and click the registration button. This will take you to the Beanstack website. Scroll down and click *Register an Individual or Family*. Then click *I am registering myself*.

STEP TWO: Now you need to enter your information:

- First and last name:** Enter your full name
- Username:** You should use your student ID
- Email:** School email is OK to use
- PIN:** Use any four numbers you'll remember
- Do you have a library card:** Enter your library card number if you have one, but this isn't necessary to participate.
- How old are you:** Select your age
- What grade level are you in:** Select your grade
- What school do you attend:** Pick your school (if homeschool, select other)
- Register for the Great reading Race**
- Please select a teacher:** Pick your teacher from the list (listed by school)

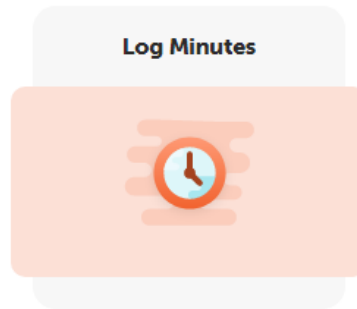
GREAT READING RACE: LOG YOUR READING

STEP ONE: Visit fountaindale.org/grr and click the log reading button. This will take you to the Beanstack website. Click *Sign In* and enter your username and PIN.

STEP TWO: Click the button at the top of the screen labeled *Log Reading*, then click *Log Minutes*.



STEP THREE: Enter your reading information like this:

- Select a day:** Click the date on the calendar that you read
- Title:** Enter the title of the book you read on this day
- Author:** Enter the author of the book
- Time spent reading:** Enter the time you read on this day (in minutes)
- Click the log button. Your reading session has been added!
- You can either log another session or close the window if you're done.
