# Paper Dahlia Wreath 

## Materials

Cardboard circle (About 5 Inches in Diameter)
$81 / 2 \times 11$ Paper ( 15 sheets), quartered (any color)
Hot Glue Gun \& Glue Sticks
Stapler (optional)
Instructions

1. Take the wide end of the paper quarter and roll it into a cone. You want one end to be tight with a vertical triangle on the other. If you don't quite get the shape you want, shift it till you get the desire cone width. Bend the tight end inward to secure.
a. (Optional): staple the end to keep it from unfurling.
2. Put a small dab of glue about a half inch into the cardboard circle and secure it. Apply more glue until a seal forms. Continue to apply cones until you have a ring with about 18 cones.
3. Continue inward with a second layer of cones, layering the row over the first. This should be around 17 cones.
4. Apply the third layer. The last few cones should be snug.
5. Glue on either some magnet strips or hook for later display.
