

SETUP


Step 1: Power on Fire Tablet

Press the button on the top, right corner to power on the device.




Step 2: Unlock the Screen

Unlock the screen by swiping up.




Step 3: Choose Your Content

Biblioboard

Discover exciting eBooks that are free to anyone in Illinois, even without a library card. Enjoy quarterly Popup Picks and works from Illinois authors. Simply select Fountaindale Library and start reading.



Boundless

Explore an extensive collection of eBooks, audiobooks and digital media with ease. You can even set personal reading goals, track your progress and earn badges. You will need your library card and PIN to use this app.



Freegal Music+

Enjoy more than 15 million songs and music videos, including today's current hits and Sony Music's catalog of legendary artists. Stream for up to five hours per day and download five free songs each week. You will need your library card and PIN to use this app.



Hoopla

Access thousands of movies, TV shows, music, eBooks, audiobooks and graphic novels when and where you want. You will need your library card and PIN to create an account. If you already have an account, please log in with your email and password.



Libby

Borrow from a robust collection of eBooks, audiobooks and magazines, including bestsellers, new releases and classics. You will need your library card and PIN to use this app.



Kanopy

Stream thousands of independent films, documentaries and kid's movies and TV shows, including titles from A24, The Criterion Collection, The Great Courses, PBS Kids and More. You will need your library card and PIN to create an account. If you already have an account, please log in with your email and password.






PressReader

View and download full versions of the world's best newspapers and magazines, including local favorites like the *Chicago Tribune* and *The New York Times*, without ads, paywalls or incomplete story snippets. To sign in, choose Library or Group and then search for Fountaindale Library. You will need your library card and PIN to use this app.

Be sure to log out of your accounts before returning the Fire tablet. If you forget, we will log out of any linked accounts once the tablet is returned.

ACCESSING THE BUILT-IN LIBRARY

Fire tablets come preloaded with a collection of eBooks available to be read. To access them, select Library from the top toolbar on the home screen. To see all available eBooks, select Show More and then Open Kindle. From here, you will see the entire library and have the option to sort or filter books based on your preference.



ACCESSIBILITY FUNCTIONS

The Fire tablet provides accessibility functions for the visually impaired, including a VoiceView Screen Reader. While this function is turned on, the tablet will read aloud whatever was last touched on the screen. To open or confirm a selection, double-tap that same selection.

The Fire tablet also provides screen magnification so you can zoom in. You may adjust the font size or color inversion to make reading more comfortable for your eyes. Closed Captioning for videos is also available.
