SETUP

Step 1: Connect to TV

Connect the Roku Ultra to an HDMI port on your TV using the HDMI cable provided.



Step 2: Connect to Power

Use the included power adapter to connect your Roku Ultra to a power outlet.



Step 3: Power on TV and Select Input

Use your TV remote to power on the TV and select the HDMI input you used to connect the Roku Ultra.



Step 4: Connect to Wi-Fi

From the home screen, use the Roku remote to navigate to Settings, then continue to arrow right to Network and finally, Wireless.

On the Wireless screen, select your Wi-Fi network. If your network is password protected, you will be prompted to enter your password.

LINKING YOUR ACCOUNT

Hoopla

You will need an active hoopla account and access to a web browser to link to the hoopla app. If you have an account, press Next, otherwise visit **hoopladigital.com** to create an account first.

Log into your hoopla account from a web browser. Once logged in, visit **hoopladigital.com/link** and enter the unique code displayed on your screen. This can also be done through the settings menu on the hoopla app.

You have 20 checkouts per month available to use on your hoopla account. Be sure to log out of your account before returning the Roku. If you forget, we will log out of any linked accounts once the Roku is returned.

LINKING YOUR ACCOUNT

Kanopy

You will need an active Kanopy account and access to a web browser to link to the Kanopy app. If you have an account, proceed to the next step, otherwise, visit **kanopy.com** to create an account first.

From the home screen, select Settings from the sidebar menu. Next, select Login at the top. Log into your Kanopy account from a web browswer. Once logged in, visit **kanopy.com/link** and enter the unique code displayed on your screen. This can also be done through the settings menu on the Kanopy app.

You have 30 tickets per month available to use on your Kanopy account. Be sure to log out of your account before returning the Roku. If you forget, we will log out of any linked accounts once the Roku is returned.
